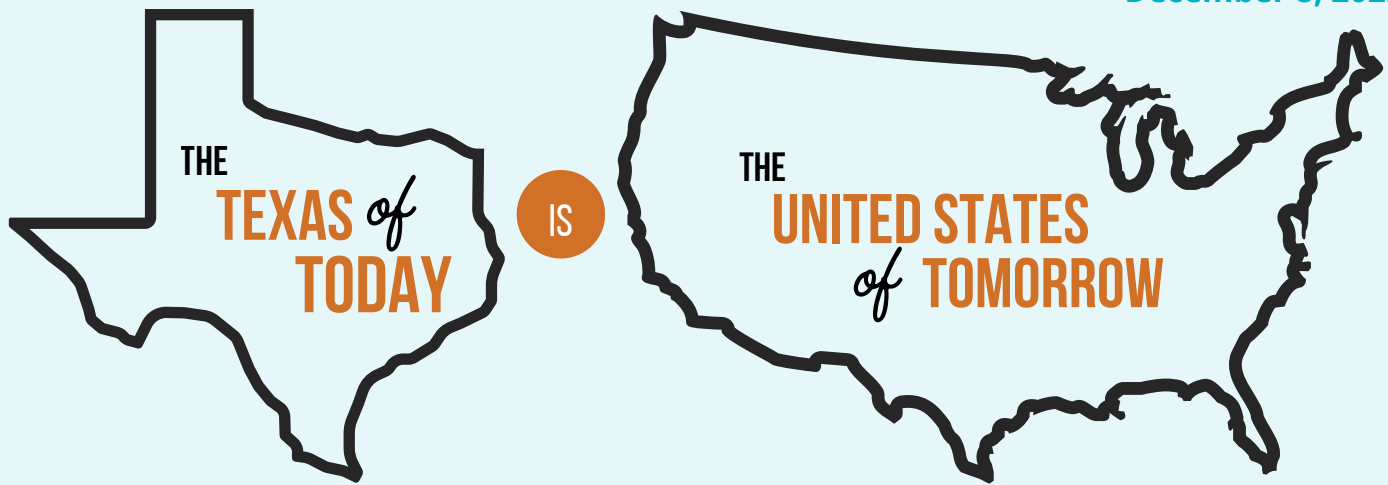
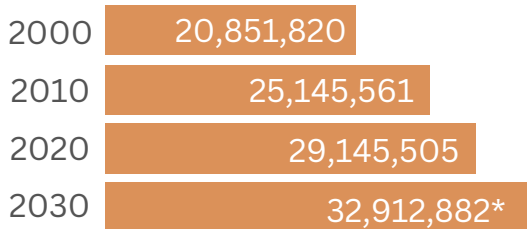




Texas' growing and diverse population, geography, and array of cultures are only a few of the benefits that make the Lone Star State an ideal place to conduct public health research.

TEXAS *is* UNINSURED

Overall, Texas ranks highest in the country for uninsured residents (16.4% vs. 7.9% in the U.S.).

1 in 5 women of childbearing age in Texas (21.6%) is uninsured, compared to 10.2% in the U.S.



Between 2022-2023, Texas added an average of **1,500** new residents a day.

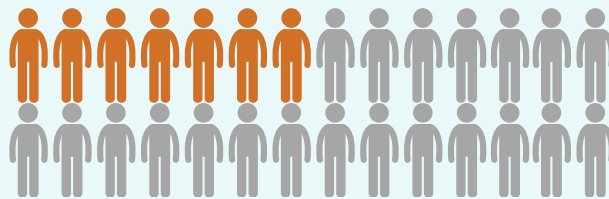

Texas has the **second-largest population** of children under 18, representing **10%** of all children in the U.S.

Nearly **1 out of every 3 households** in Texas is home to families with children under 18.

Every **80 seconds** a child is born somewhere in Texas.

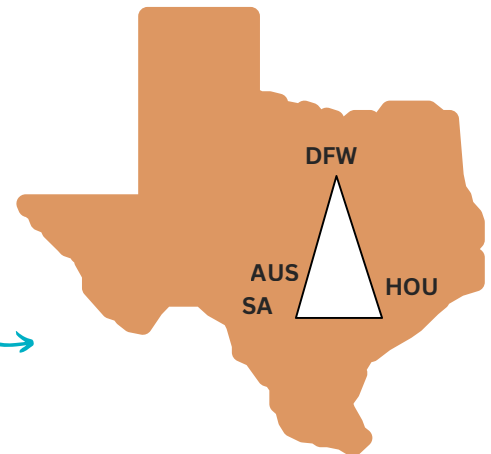

TEXAS *is* RURAL

3 out of 10 Texans live in places other than the state's major metropolitan areas, which connect to form the **Texas Triangle.**

In Texas, there are 32 counties with **no primary care doctor** and 74 counties that **do not have a hospital.**
