Petition for Equivalency Credit

Transfer credit for equivalent courses taken elsewhere may be awarded and used to meet degree requirements. The course must be equivalent to a SBMI degree program course and approved through a Petition for Equivalency Credit (PEC). The maximum number of transferable semester credit hours is 3 for certificates, 12 for the master's, 36 for the PhD, and 21 for the DHI.

Credit is only given to courses that match the current SBMI Course Catalog. Courses for which grades of less than "B" were earned will not be accepted for equivalency. Courses must have been completed within the last five years to qualify. The submitted syllabus from the course taken must be from the semester and year the student completed the course. Syllabi from any other semester or year will not be accepted and the PEC will be denied.

Instructions:

Before you begin, please be sure that an official transcript from the transferring school is on file with the Office of the Registrar showing completion of the course with a satisfactory grade (B or above).

- 1. Complete Section A of the PEC Form.
- 2. Attach a copy of the course syllabus from the transferring school.
- 3. Submit PEC Form and course syllabus to Office of Academic Affairs for processing.
